Travel Tips Avoiding Bed Bugs

Bed Bugs are hitchhikers only transferring to your home through your travels. Here are a few quick tips to avoid bringing these unwanted human blood suckers as house guests.

- ❑ Use luggage that is easily washable. Tote bags, shoulder bags etc. After a trip, wash these items in very warm water or simply dry them in the dryer on HIGH HEAT.
- ❑ Wash all clothing in very HOT water or simply dry items on HIGH HEAT.
- ❑ Inspect the living area for any signs of bed bugs. Before you enter the guest bedroom/living area, STOP, and leave luggage in the hallway.
 - Inspect the bedding area
 - Remove all Sheets and look for living signs of bed bugs.
 - Look for dark stains on the mattress cover. It could be almost black in color and almost like mold.
 - Lift up the seems of the mattress for signs of bed bugs
 - Literally lift the mattress to inspect the underside
 - Take down and inspect the wall head board, look in the corners especially. These bed boards are hung like a picture and can be taken on and off easily.
 - Call House Keeping to remake your bed ☺
 - Inspect the living area:
 - Check the chairs/couches.
 - Pull the cushions out and check the bottom. Eggs look like uncooked rice and are the size of a mustard seed
 - Check along the baseboards, electrical outlets and in the closet
 - Check behind pictures, in drawers, and underneath things.
 - General Notes:
 - Keep your luggage elevated
 - Don't forget to wash or dry on HOT WATER/ HIGH HEAT
 - If you find bugs, call the manager and ask to be moved to another room, preferably on another floor and not above or under the room you just inspect, Repeat inspection.
